Pr. He has been posted in the CREDOC (Research Center on living conditions) where he has headed the Public policy evaluation department, and has thereafter headed the research team GRASS (Research team on social and sociability issues). In 2008-09, he has been invited professor at the Canadian national institute for Scientific research (INRS, Quebec). His research team focus mainly on poverty, welfare, family and social protection policies, as well as urban sociology. He has written seven books and contributed to many academic publications - books or journals - in France and in other countries.
